Welcome to the Alaska Folk Festival!

Folk music is one of Alaska's most vital and widely practiced arts. The Alaska Folk Festival provides an opportunity for musicians and folk aficionados from throughout the state, British Columbia, and the Yukon to share and develop this art.

This year's Festival will feature Guest Artist Eric Von Schmidt, more than 120 performing musicians from all parts of the North, 24 workshops, seven performances, and a square dance. With the exception of the Guest Artist, all musicians are performing without compensation and many have come at their own expense from distant parts of the state. The Festival would be impossible without hundreds of hours of volunteer effort by many individuals and organizations. 
