S.S.Co. Crew all saved.

1911

D.A.Disp. 3/25/1911 says she and the Scottish str.  
"Irisbrook" collided in the Eng. Channel last  
night. Both vessels sunk in a few minutes but  
miraculously there was no loss of life.
