Emp. 5/25/1927 Seattle tug "Warren" chartered by Independent Gravel Co. is feared lost with all hands in Strait of Juan de Fuca. Last seen at 02:00 yesterday morning. Her barge was found drifting today, and no sign of the tug.

Emp. 5/28/1927/8 Body of cook on the "Warrén" was found by diver A.E.Hook, who 'battled an octopus to recover the body in about 50' of water near Pt. Wilson, etc.....

Emp. 5/26/1927/6 Hope for the men on the "Warren" has been given up. Wreckage has been found near Pt. Wilson.
