Letter from Mikhail Dmitrievich Teben'kov [Novo-Arkhangelsk?] 15/ VII-1847 to G.
Archimandritoff. 1 ℓ

Russian skipper Archimandritoff, Commander of the steamer Nicholai I is instructed to take freight from the English ship Cowlits to the storekeeper Tacharnikoff on the Stikine River. The ship Cowlits will accompany Nicholai I to the destination for a meeting with the English and conference with Stikine Indians, including four chiefs.

Letter from A. Teben'kov, Nova-Arkhangelsk dated 1864 to Stepan Ushin [Nuchagak?] 2 ℓ

A reply to Ushin's request for books to plan an educational program in the community. Following a list of books being sent is a teaching program outline including the science skills and other basic learning which the Company felt important.

Letter from Dmitrii Petrovich Maksutov, [Novo-Arkhangelsk?] dated 2 June 1864, to Stepan Ushin, Nushagak. 1 ℓ

Instructs Ushin, a clerk for the Company to board the steamer Constantine and proceed to Unalaska where he will be assistant to the superintendent of the District.
