ACQUISITION: The Alaska State Library received the collection from Betty West Miller representing the Gastineau Pioneers Book Committee, Acc. #2001-67, in September 2001. Addition to collection, received from Marie Darlin of the Gastineau Pioneers Book Committee, October 2004, Acc. #2004-62.

ACCESS: The collection is unrestricted.

COPYRIGHT: Request for permission to publish or reproduce material from the collection should be discussed with the Librarian.

PROCESSING: The files' original order and labels were retained. Files were transferred to acid-free containers. Files are arranged in alphabetical order by family name. Acc. #2004-62 files retained in original folders; will require further processing.

SCOPE AND CONTENTS NOTE

The files were kept by the Gastineau Pioneers Book Committee as they compiled information on Juneau families for the book, *Gastineau Channel Memories, 1880-1959*. Files contain correspondence, articles and, sometimes, photos sent by families for inclusion in the book. Each family's file also includes a draft of the story's form as condensed for use in the book. As the title states the bulk of the information covers the period from ca. 1880 to 1959.
