**ACQUISITION:** The collection is a compilation of professional photographers who have worked in Alaska in between 1878-1919. These views were either copied from other institutions or donated or found in the backlog of ASL collections. The collection is ongoing. (Acc. No. 1995-33, 2002-96 (added 6/2003), 2003-24).

**ACCESS:** The collection is available for viewing, however, the photographs may not be photocopied.

**COPYRIGHT:** Request for permission to publish or reproduce material from the collection should be discussed with the Librarian.

**PROCESSING:** The photographs were numbered and inventoried in July 2002 by volunteer Alison Dickinson. Photographs are sleeved in Mylar and added as they are received. An inventory which includes photographer name, PCA number (shortened name+number), description, photographer's number if known, type of print (original or copy), and the Library's accession number, if known.

## Scope and Contents Note

The collection of early Alaskan photographers was created by the Library in its early days. Since that time, separate collections were developed for some of the larger collections. Many of the images are copy prints; original prints are noted in the inventory. If an accession is known, it is also indicated. Photographers represented in the collection include: Reuben Albertstone, Guy F. Cameron, Cann, George G. Cantwell, F.D. Cheney, Asahel Curtis, George Davison, B.B. Dobbs, J. Malcolm Greany, O.D.
