Wilma and Robert Knox lived in Alaska from 1951-1984. The couple worked as photo 'journalists; she was a free-lance photographer and he worked for newspapers in Anchorage and Fairbanks. The couple traveled extensively in Alaska and wrote *All About Camping in Alaska and the Yukon*. They retired to Wyoming in 1984.
