1. Anna Alto, Oscar Alto, Woman in center is Heidi, his nephew's wife (they have identical twin daughters)
2. From left to right: Stepdad John Miller who Holda met much later on a trip to Sweden, Carl Carlson, Mom Holda, Ed Carlson
3. [A small plane with three men in front.]
4. Carl Carlson
5. Head of "A" Company, Priboloffs
6. Carl and Ed's mom Holda, she lived with her family on Bainbridge Island. Ba/S were raised by their dad. Lived on boat or logged Seymour Canal.
7. Carl now says it is the "cannery on south end of Admiralty Island". Could well be Tyee.
8. Entrance Island 1935 or 1936. Annual get together of fur farmers on various islands...
House of OTTO WILD-white hat/shirt,
wife ALLICE WILD-seated on steps.
Pack Creek Bear Man STAN PRICE tallest in black.
FRANCES "ED" CARLTON [CARLSON] 2nd from PR,
ED CARLTON [CARLSON] 3rd from PR,
ROD SUDMAN white shirt,
JACK DAVIS with floppy hat,
GENE RANDALL far PR end,
BURT GRISWOLD in plaid.
9. [Same house, 6 men on stairs]

10. Windham Bay? CLIFF PATTON bottom front PR end. He fell off Juneau Cold Storage dock drunk and died.
STAN PRICE wearing glasses.
EDNA MAE PRICE his wife face in profile.
OTTO WILD on PL side, white hair and shirt.
FRANCES "ED" CARLSON at low PL corner end on grass.
Many of the others were visitors.
Stan Price had two-masted sailboat called "Edna Mae".
11. DANIEL ATTONGORUK, WILSON SHOOGHNBOACK [?]
12. CARL CARLSON - tall guy in center
EMMONS - far PL buck sergeant
WAYNE MARCANNON - 2nd in from PL (Carlson's best friend)
DANIEL ATTUNGORUK - from Pt. Hope?
Carlson was calling the man at center fromt "YUKATISH" and saying he came from the Cook Inlet area. Also said OKTOLLIK was famous - went to London to save whales/whaling?
13. CPL F.E Carlson
CPL CE Carlson
14. Carlson identified him as WAYNE MARCANNON (sp?), maybe on Unakleet
15. John Oktollik
16. St. Paul - town. Priboloffs. 1942-1943
17. Wilson Shoogangorak. Carlson also called this man "YUKATISH" from Point Hope
18. Baseball field St. Paul
