BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Mary Juanita Pauley was born in Tampa and was a life long resident of the area, with the exception of the time she spent working on the Alaska Pipeline in the late 1970s. Ms. Pauley was a Draftsman at Brown & Root, for whom she worked on a project related to the Pipeline. She also drafted for NASA, and Bell Laboratories. Her grandmother and aunts homesteaded in Alaska before her. Juanita Pauley was also a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution. She died at age 83 on May 3, 2011, in Florida.
