




Introduction

In the following pages, the Alaska State Library presents a summary of the public library statistics collected from FY93 through FY97. The tables and graphs in Part I offer a comparison by fiscal year with a breakout for the 3 major public libraries. Parts II and III are the tables for FY96 and FY97 by library name and population. Included are statistics reported by the libraries as well as selected per capita computations. The libraries included in each year's reporting are those that received the *Public Library Assistance Grant* for that year.

The statistics collected are based on the Federal State Cooperative System for Public Library Data (FSCS) of the U.S. Department of Education, National Center for Education Statistics. By using this national system and its definitions of terms, Alaska's data is comparable with that of the other 49 states and the District of Columbia. Of course extreme caution should be used in comparing any one library with national or state averages. This is especially true of Alaskan libraries which tend to be atypical in size, and population served. The national data for FY95 is available in a publication entitled *Public Libraries in the U. S. : 1995* by the National Center for Education Statistics, U. S. Department of Education. Unedited data for FY96 is also available at that site.

We hope this publication will be useful to administrators and library boards in planning, budgeting and public relations activities. The tables in this document are also published on the Web at <http://www.educ.state.ak.us/lam/library/dev/plstats/plstats.html>. All the information reported in the Annual Reports has been entered into a spreadsheet and specialized tables can be generated upon request. Please contact the State Library if you need special statistical information.

General Information On the Use of the Tables for Public Libraries

The data included in these tables was reported by public libraries in the *Annual Reports* for FY96 and FY97. Although all libraries reported income and expenditure information, not all libraries collected the same circulation and collection statistics. A number of libraries did not collect attendance, reference or program data. To make the tables more readable, data elements reported as zero and those reported as not collected have been left blank.

The population data was adjusted for some libraries in order to ensure a consistent method of counting and to eliminate double counting. The same sources and methods were used in this publication as in previous editions. In most cases, populations attributed to the *city and borough* libraries correspond to the populations of the area from which they receive tax revenue. The source of this information was the Department of Community and Regional Affairs' *Certification of Population* for the years cited. In the case of libraries located in unincorporated areas not certified by DCRA, the figures reported on the *Annual Report* were used. The population of legal service areas for libraries in the Mat-Su and Kenai Boroughs were calculated as in previous years. Using DCRA figures, each library was credited with the population base of the city and a percentage of the borough wide population based on the percentage of materials circulated by each library. A. Holmes Johnson Memorial Library in Kodiak was given the population of the Kodiak Borough minus the populations of Chiniak, Old Harbor, Ouzinkie and Port Lions.

The last library entity listed in each table is identified as *Regional Services*. The data entered here is a total of the statistics reported for the *Books by Mail* programs run by the two Regional Libraries in Fairbanks and Juneau. The population assigned to this "library" is the official state population, minus the populations of those communities served by libraries. By using the statewide population figure and reporting *all* public library services, we feel the data more accurately reflects the true status of library services in Alaska.

The Tables

Table 1: Circulation and Interlibrary Loan

This table shows how often different types of library materials (books, magazines, audio tapes, videos, etc.) were checked out of the library as well as how often the library lent or received materials through Interlibrary Loan.

In FY97 Alaska's circulation per capita was 6.19. The FY95 national per capita was 6.4. The national average for Interlibrary Loan lending in FY95 was 35.2 items per 1,000 population. In Alaska, it was 31.63 in FY97. The number of items borrowed by Alaskan libraries is much higher than the national average. In FY97 Alaskan libraries borrowed 54.16 items per 1,000 population compared to the FY95 national figure of 38.7.

Table 2: Collections

Table 2 provides an overview of the size of a library's book, audio, video, electronic and magazine collections, the number of book volumes added during the year, and the number of book volumes per capita. In FY95 national book and serial volumes per capita was 2.8, up slightly from 2.7 in FY93. In Alaska the FY97 per capita volumes rose to 3.30.

Statistics continue to show changes in public library collections from print to media formats. In FY93 public libraries nationally reported 30.18 videos per 1,000 population. Alaska reported 53.99. In FY95 the national numbers were 44.9 videos per 1,000 population, while Alaska reported 88.58 in FY97. The FY96 survey introduced a new count, materials in electronic format. Although these items (e.g. computer disks, magnetic tapes, and CD-Roms) were previously counted in the *other materials* category, this format is becoming increasingly important in libraries. Managers and decision makers frequently ask for this count.

Table 3: Income

This table provides information on the sources of income for Alaskan libraries: Local (city or borough), State, Federal Government, and Other funding. **Other** is important for many of Alaska's smaller libraries because they are operated by private, non-profit organizations. The income from these non governmental sources is reported under this category. Although it is hard to make comparisons year by year for the individual data elements in this table, generally, local support as represented by local governments has increased. State and federal funding has decreased. In FY93 local government funding represented 87.96% of library budgets statewide. 5.39% was provided by state government, 2.36% by federal dollars and 4.29% other. In FY97 local government provided 89.13% of the funding for libraries, only 4.12% was income from state government, the federal share had dropped to 1.87%, and other was 4.88%.

Table 4: Expenditures

This table shows how libraries spend their budgets. Columns are included for salaries, benefits, collections (books, magazines, audiovisual materials, etc.), operating expenditures (maintenance, travel, services and supplies), and capital expenditures (if any). Nationally, in FY95, salaries and benefits accounted for 64.9% of the total operating budget, library collections 15.1% and all other expenditures 20%. The total operating expenditures per capita was \$20.88. For FY97 in Alaska, 64% was spent on staff expenditures; 11.8% on collections; and 24.2% on other. Per capita operational expenditures were \$33.86.

Table 5: Expenditures on Collections

Table 5 subdivides the library collection expenditures by format: books, subscriptions, audiovisuals and other (microforms, computer software, maps, etc.) Collection expenditures per capita rose from \$3.48 in FY93 to \$4.06 in FY97. In FY93 Alaskan libraries spent 59% of their collections budget on books and serials; 23.1% on periodicals; 6.4% on audiovisuals; and 11.5% on other materials. In FY97 expenditures for books and serials represented 53.8% of the collections budget; 26.7% for periodicals; 8.7 % for audiovisuals and only 10.8% for other materials.

Table 6: Staff and Volunteers

This table shows the composition of the library staff: Librarians with a masters degree in library science (MLS), all people working as librarians, and the technical and clerical staff. It also includes information on volunteers and the number of hours contributed to the library by volunteers, although these numbers may not be as reliable as the numbers reported for paid staff.

The FY93-FY97 statewide chart indicates that in the area of staffing, libraries have scarcely kept up with population growth. Anchorage Municipal Libraries gained 6 MLS positions and Juneau Public Library gained almost 2. Some smaller libraries lost MLS positions for a statewide net gain of 5.4. Even with over 20 University of Arizona Distance Delivery MLS graduates entering the profession in FY94 and FY95, it appears small public libraries still have difficulty finding certified personnel.

Table 7: Hours, Attendance, Reference, and Programs

Table 7 covers the number of hours per week the library is open, annual library attendance, the number of reference questions answered, and the number of programs presented during the year. The last three are indicators of how heavily the library is used. It is the attendance and reference question data elements that small libraries find the most difficult to count and report accurately. The State Library encourages libraries to use a sampling technique as described in the *Manual for Small Libraries* to increase the reliability of this information.



















