about particular complaints.






Don Tillman, genetics professor, is getting married. Or he will be, when





## Meet the Author: Zoe Ferraris 7pm at the Innovation Lab




Zoë Ferraris moved to Jeddah, Saudi Arabia in the aftermath of the first Gulf War. She lived in a conservative Muslim community with her then-husband and his family, a group of Saudi-Palestinians.

Her debut novel, Finding Nouf won the LA Times Book Award. That novel and its follow-ups, City of Veils and Kingdom of Strangers, have been international bestsellers, publishing in over forty countries.

A new children's book, The Hunt for the Pyxis, will publish this summer. It is the first of a trilogy for mid-grade readers.
