- 2-3 community volunteers (site manager and site monitor)
- Location for serving and storing food
- Handout the meals while completing the **Daily Meal Count Form** and send in paperwork

And then...

Food Bank will provide:


- 2 stipends for site managing volunteers
- Training
- Food (and we cover all transporting cost)

Before you serve food



Site Manager

- Ensures that food is stored securely and inventoried
- Ensures that food is served according to schedule
- Fills out daily meal counts and sends them in weekly
- Notifies Food Bank of site closure or change of location (even for one day)
- Orders more food from Food Bank



Site Monitor


- Conducts 3-4 site visits
- Fills out the required site visit forms and sends them into Food Bank
- Supports the Site Manager
- May not have any affiliation with the SFSP site other than as its monitor (monitors are required to be 3rd party to the feeding site. They do not attend the site on a regular bases.)



Alternate

- This position is suggested, not required as the manager and monitor positions are
- Is available to help the manager or the monitor
- Can take over one of the positions if they original people cannot finish the season
- Can substitute if the manager or monitor is unavailable
