


Deep Freeze Downloading and Installation instructions

Deep Freeze software prevents any unwelcome or unwanted changes users made while in-session from remaining on the computer. It's really simple. By restarting your computers, systems are returned to the desired state. Meanwhile, user data can be stored safely on a network drive or in a ThawSpace to be retained across reboots.

Part One: Downloading Deep Freeze


1. In your browser address bar type www.4shared.com. Press **Enter**.




2. Click on **Login** at the top of the page.




3. A drop down box opens. Enter **Login Name** and **Password**. Click **Login**. To obtain the login name and password email alex.pock@alaska.gov




4. A new page opens. **Click** the box next to the DFWks.zip file. Click **Download**.




5. A new page opens. Ignore the ads and various download buttons. Only **click the blue Download button**.




6. A new page opens. **Click the gray Free Download button**. The next couple of steps are specific to the web browser. For Internet Explorer see steps 7 and 8. For Mozilla Firefox see steps 9-11.




7. For Internet Explorer: A tab opens at the bottom of the page. Click **Save**.




8. For Internet Explorer: Once the file downloads, click **Open folder**. Go to step 12.




9. For Mozilla Firefox: A pop-up window opens.
Click Save File. Click OK.




10. For Mozilla Firefox: To save the file to a thumb drive, click the **Firefox** tab. Then click **Downloads**.



11. For Mozilla Firefox: A new window opens. **Right** click on the file DFWks.zip. Click **Open Containing Folder**.




12. Both browsers: A new window opens. **Right** click on the file DFWks.zip. Click **Send to**. Then click the drive location. (For ex. DVD R/W Drive [E:])




Part Two: Installing and initializing Deep Freeze

1. Turn off **Windows Automatic Updates**

Updates. Click the **Start** button, click **All Programs**, and then click **Windows Update**.




2. Windows update opens. Click **Change settings**.



3. Click the drop down menu and click **Never check for updates (not recommended)**.


Click **Save**. By doing this you will avoid having Deep Freeze lock you into a restart loop. It will require you to occasionally thaw Deep Freeze and download the updates manually.



4. All background utilities and antivirus software must be disabled and all applications should be closed prior to installation. These programs may interfere with the installation, which could result in Deep Freeze not functioning correctly.

5. Click the **Start** button, click **My Computer**, click the drive you saved the Deep Freeze file to. Double click the **DFks.wks** file to install. (You may receive a warning asking if you want to allow the program to make changes to your computer. Click **Yes**.) Click the **Install** button. This will install the program and restart the computer.



Upon restart the computer is automatically frozen and protected by Deep Freeze.


6. To log into Deep Freeze and make changes to your desktop and install programs/updates: Hold Shift and double click on the Deep Freeze



icon in the system tray to open the program. Enter the password (the default password is **123454321**) and click the **OK** button.




7. Once you have entered the password the Deep Freeze window will have 4 tabs. Click the **Password** tab and change the password. Click the **Apply and Reboot** button. Save your new password in a safe place so it is not forgotten.



8. Computers must be Thawed* for any permanent changes to take effect. Installation of software requires one or more restarts to complete the installation.

*To do this you will need to select the **Boot Thawed** option in the Deep Freeze main menu. Click **Apply and Reboot**. An information box opens to confirm that the computer will be thawed upon all subsequent restarts. Click **OK**. A new pop-up window confirms that your changes have been saved and asks if you want to reboot your computer. Click **Yes**. Install updates or programs and once the machine has finished installing and restarting, log back into Deep freeze and change the setting back to “Boot Frozen.” Upon restart the computer is automatically frozen and protected by Deep Freeze.
