ALASKA STATE LIBRARY, ARCHIVES, AND MUSEUM WINTER SCHEDULE BEGINS SEPTEMBER 27

The Alaska State Museum will be closed on Sunday, September 25, 2016, reopening on Monday, September 26 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

On Tuesday, September 27, the State Library, Archives, and Museum will shift to winter hours which are Tuesday through Saturday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. The Fr. Andrew P. Kashevaroff (APK) State Library, Archives, and Museum building will be closed to the public on Sundays and Mondays during the winter season. Division staff will be available by phone and e-mail Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

During the winter schedule, the cost for museum admission drops to \$5 per visit. Visitors 18 years and younger, Friends of the State Library, Archives, & Museum, and those with museum passes are admitted free.
