Compilation - Sketch of the rivers discharging into the estuaries of Bristol Bay, from Nushagak Bay to Togiak Bay, with particular reference to the lake sources of the Nushagak (Illyagik), Wood (Aleknagik), Snake (Dreniak), and Egushak Rivers

The coast line is from C. & G. S. chart No. 8802, edition of May, 1909. The other data were compiled from sketches and information furnished by the following persons familiar with the region: Dr. L. H. French, who, as census enumerator, in 1910, visited the upper settlements, and mapped his route; Gordon Waller, prospector; Harriner Smith, prospector and mining promoter; Searsen, prospector; Timmerman, prospector; A. H. Mittendorf, fur trader; Otto Larsen, fur trader; H. A. Hockmeier, salteryman; Yessili, native, from Mulchatna country; Ivan, Stepan, and Ah-kai-ak, natives from Ahleknuguk Lake country.
