Historical Note

Register sign-in for visitors to the Alaska Building at the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific Exposition, Summer 1909. AYP exposition was held on the campus of the University of Washington, Seattle. The district of Alaska participated in this regional industrial-economic fair.

Scope and Contents Note

Register information requested from visitor varies with each volume, but could include date of visit, name, business, interested in, home address, and Seattle address. Volume one inside page, handwritten, "Alaskans Only Indexed Alphabetically;" includes the date, name, Alaska address (or sometimes a Yukon Territory address) and city address of the visitor.
